Members must have paid their Hunting Subscription to the club for the season, **by standing order only** (forms available on MHC website)

Those that live **outside** the MHC hunt country are allowed **TWO days** with each hunt. Those **within** the MHC hunt country are allowed **ONE day** with each hunt.

#### All days have a 50% reduced cap
