Cross Country Ride on Sunday 10th November 2024

The course will be open for walking from the 2nd of November 2024 and every **COMPETITOR MUST WALK the COURSE** and no dogs allowed. The map will be on the MHC website on 1st November. The course starts to the West of the Bungalow at South Croxton Grange on the Queniborough road. Parking for course walking is at the Barrowcliffe Cross Country Course, What3Words are: ///leafing.daring.cuddled and the start field are ///circling.crusaders.dish

In addition to the start/finish there are a total of 10 markers, with red on your right and white on your left (Ignore Blue markers which are the Foxhunter Course), all of which must be complied with. The finish is in a field next to the Car and Lorry Park. Please assume that all gates will be closed on the day unless marked on the Gate. The markers are as follows:

- MARKER 1 White Marker in the hedgerow.
- MARKER 2 White Marker in the hedgerow.
- MARKER 3 White Marker on Pole in middle of the Field.
- MARKER 4 Red Marker in the hedgerow.
- MARKER 5 Red Marker in the field.
- MARKER A Open Gate
- MARKER B Open Gate
- MARKER 6 Red Marker in the fence.
- MARKER 7 White Marker in the hedgerow.
- MARKER 8 White Marker in the hedgerow.
- MARKER 9 White Marker in the hedgerow.
- MARKER 10 Red Marker in the fence.

WIRE, the committee will make all effort to remove the wire from the course.

The Lorry Park is at Barrowcliffe X-Country Course, only off road car parking in a different field at Lorry Park. Will riders please make sure they are mounted and ready to leave the assembly point in the Field above the Lorry Park 11.45am.

Declarations and Horse Numbers can be collected from the secretary situated in the Lorry Park between 10.00am and 11.30am. **Reminder: rider numbers need to be printed and their own bib number provided.**

The Quorn Huntsman will then escort the riders to the start.

There will be a set of scales at the Secretary's for competitors to confirm their weight and at the finish for prize-winners to weigh-in after the race. Please check if you are eligible for any special prizes when you declare at the Secretary's as it will be too late to claim them after the Ride. All Riders must carry the minimum weight of 12stone and be a minimum age of 16.
